



## STUDENT CLIMATE SURVEY *2017-2018*

In recognition of the importance of school climate, the Alhambra Unified School District (AUSD) developed an annual survey to assess the perception of school climate among students. This survey is of utmost importance to the district, as it is required under the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). The LCAP describes the goals and specific actions to achieve those goals for all pupils, and the survey is just one of the many ways to identify student needs.

The Annual Student Climate Survey is being administered from **March 19, 2018 through March 23, 2018** to randomly selected classrooms grades 4 through 12 at each of our schools in the form of a Google Document. The survey provides students with an opportunity to communicate their perceptions about their learning environment, school safety and student engagement, etc. The survey responses are anonymous. The survey is voluntary.
